

Dutch Postcard Christmas Table Runner Center Part 2

What you'll need:

- Red fabric 6 small stars (2 1/4 x 2 1/4 inches) and 6 large stars (2.5 x 2.5 inches)
This includes a surcharge if you appliqué it by hand.
- Green Fabric 6 Small Christmas Trees (2 x 1.5 inches) and 6 Large Christmas Trees (2 1/4 x 3 inches)
- Rulers, rotary cutter, water soluble pen, chalk or frixtion pen, pencil, needles, scissors and pins, yarn
- Fussible web

Traditional

You need PDF part 2.1 for this. Place the templates on the fabric, draw and cut out. Use a chalk pencil or frixtion pen to mark where you need to saw the parts on to the circle. I'm using a light box here and put the PDF part 2.0 underneath the already finished circle. But you can also just measure the center of each circle part and draw a line. Saw all pieces on the right place and iron.

Raw Edge

You can use the 2.1 template without the surcharge. Draw the figures on the fusible web, cut out, iron on the back of the fabric, cut out and iron in the right place. You can do this by placing the pdf part 2.0 template under the already finished circle, but you can also just take the middle each part and draw a line. Sew everything with a small zigzag stitch or blanket stitch. Iron everything.
