

# Quilt Along: Dutch Postcard 2026

## The Tulips and 2 x border Week 2

### What you'll need:

#### Orange fabric 2 types:

- For de middle part of the tulip you have 3 size:

Big: 1 1/8 x 1.5 inch x 6.

Middle: 1 x 1,5 inch x 12.

Small: 7/8 x 7/8 inch x 6.

- For the tulip 3 sizes:

Big: 1 3/4 inch x 1 3/4 inch x 6

Middle: 1.5 x 1.5 inch x 12

Small: 1 3/8 x 1 3/8 x 6

#### Green fabric:

- Big leaves: 1.5 inch 3/4 x 12.
- Middle size leaves: 1 1/4 x 3.4 inch x 24.
- Small leaves: 7/8 x 1 inch x 12 .

❖ White, Orange and green thread.

❖ Fusable web.

❖ The templates on pdf.

❖ Ruler, Pencil, frixtion pen, water soluble pen.

❖ Scissors, needle and pins.

❖ Glue pen or glue for applique.

❖ Lightbox would come handy.

**Note: the sizes of the fabric are the size when you do hand applique. With raw edge applique you need a bit less!**

### Raw edge applique

Use the template RAW EDGE to mark where the tulips go on the block. I used a lightbox, that makes it a lot easier. Remember that the middle peace of the tulip needs to be bigger so it falls neatly under the rest of the tulip! Draw all the templates on the right site of the fussible web (is not the sticky site) x times you need them.

Iron the pieces on to the fabric. Does it stick correctly, than cut the pieces and iron them on the right place on the block (I Also use a lightbox for that). First iron the middle piece, then the tulip over it. You draw the leaves on fussible web, iron on the fabric and cut out. You put it on the block as you like. And iron.

Then there is another tulip on the blue part. That's the middle size tulip. The tulip is 3/4 inch above the center of the blue part. Iron all parts, make sure you have enough space for the 2 leaves! Sew with a narrow zigzag on the machine.

### **Needle turn applique**

You need the PDF Needle turn applique. Cut out all parts of the template with seam allowance. Use the PDF Raw Edge, to position the tulips on the block. I used a lightbox for this and a frixtion pen to mark where they have to be placed. Start with the middle piece of the tulip and then the rest of the tulip will be placed over that.

The tulip above the blue part (the middle size tulip) comes a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch above the center of the blue block.

Than you start with the leaves. You place them how you like.

### **Border 1**

- Bleu fabric 12.5 inch x 1.5 inch..

Cut out 2 strips of blue fabric of 12.5 x 1.5 inch. Sew on the opposite site of your fan block with the tulips and Iron.
