
Block of the Month 2024

Blok 4 Double Weddingring (4 blocks)



What you'll need:

Please note! Four blocks are made to show the pattern of the double wedding ring.

- Pieces of fabric in the color you want to use. Here you can easily get rid of some scraps.
- Plain fabric for the rest
- Scissors, rotary cutter, ruler
- Pins, needles, yarn to color, glue pen
- Chalk pen, frixtion pen.
- Fundation paper or anything else for fpp.
- Template FPP or traditional

Traditional

Cut out all the molds you need and pick out the fabric. Put all the templates on fabric with a chalk pen or frixion pen and cut out. Assemble all the bows, then attach the solid color to the bow. I used a glue pen because I hate pins. It is most convenient to start with the small half ovals first, 16 pieces. Sew and assemble the inner pieces. Iron in between and iron when the block is completely finished. You do this with all 4 blocks. Iron everything well again and, if necessary, cut to size of 10.5 x 10.5 inches. Put the 4 blocks together into a square and iron.

FPP

You can use FPP here. That's only for the arches with fabrics. I did this myself because it suits me more. You'll need 8 sheets of fundation or something else. Pick out the fabrics and sew them on the paper. The order is not important here. Have the 16 bows ready. Then draw 16 half ovals and 4 inner pieces of plain fabric. Start by attaching the half ovals to the bow. I use a glue pen. Sew and iron. When you have all 16 of them ready, you can attach them to the inner pieces. Iron in between.

When the 4 blocks are ready, cut them to size if necessary and sew the 4 blocks together into a square and iron.
