

Block of the Month 2024

Blok 11 Lattice Weving









What you'll need:

- 1. Strips of fabric in 2 colors and a separate piece of fabric for the border.
- 1. Strips of light fabric and 18 strips of dark fabric about 14,5 inch (27 cm) long and 0.5 inch (1 cm) wide. I used centimeters, so the 0,5 inch with is a slightly wider.
- 2. Scissors, rotary cutter, ruler, pencil
- 3. Pins, needles, yarn by color
- 4. Interfacing for the back, glue only on one side.
- 5. A bias maker no. 12 clover.

You can choose to make the strips or ribbons in different ways. Sew the strips on the sewing machine and then turn and iron flat. Using a bias maker or making the bias by hand, see video 2. Or just use bias tape.

Make the interfacing square a little larger, because the ribbons are never precise. (I cut $24 \times 24 \text{ cm}$) When using inches adjust.

(if you make the ribbons wider, adjust the diagram with fewer blocks).

I drew the pattern with a pencil on the back, you don't really have to do that with this pattern, as long as you know where the seam allowance is/ starts. Place the glue side facing you. If you have something special for this, super. But if not, use the ironing board. So did I, works perfect.

Start with the vertical ribbons. Keep 0.5 inch or 1 centimeter of the left side free, but start pinning in the top on the edge. Secure each ribbon with a pin. Once you've secured all 18, start weaving with the other color.

The pattern is very simple. Always secure the horizontal ribbon with a pin and make sure that everything is pushed in properly. As in the video 2, I used painters tape to fix it, but first I used the iron to fix everything on Interfacing. Don't stick the painter's tape exactly on the edge but a little more inwards, (Without tape it will be more difficult to keep everything together). Remove all the pins and sew everything with the sewing machine just on the edge of the pattern. You can then remove the tape. Cut everything to size and put a border on it with a different color or pattern.

If you want to make something completely different, don't look for lattice and weaving quilt, but paper weaving. You will find more patterns that you can use.
