Border 5: 12 x Heart Blocks Applique

What you'll need:

Hwart Blocks 12 x 4.5 x 4.5 inches

- White fabric: 12 x 4,5 x 4,5 inch
- Delfst blue fabric:
- Plain blue fabric:
- Ruler, rotary cutter, scissors.
- Needles, pins, yarn.
- Fusable web.
- The templates.

Raw edge applique

Draw 12 big heart on fusible web and 12 small ones. You need the one without the seam allowance. Iron this on different kind of Delfts blue for the big heart and the little heart in plain blue. Cut the hearts out. Cut out 12 white squares 4,5 x 4,5 inch. Remove paper, look for the middle of the square and stick the big heart on. Iron. Then the same with the little one. Sew with a small zigzag.

Needle turn applique

Cut out the templates with the seam allowance. Choose the fabric for the big heart and small heart. Draw the template on fabric and cut out. Sew the 12 big hearts in the middle on the 12 white squares you need to cut out. These are 4,5 by 4,5 inch. Iron, then sew the small hearts on the big hearts and iron. .
