## Block of the Month 2024

## Blok 2 Stained Glass Quilt Block

## What you'll need:

- One piece of fabric 10.5 x 10.5 inches
- Different colors of fabric for the flower
- Fabric for making bias tape
- Bias binding, Clover or with a bias maker of 6 mm
- Scissors, rotary cutter, ruler
- Pins, needles, yarn to color, glue pen
- The template

Bias binding 6 mm, you can make it yourself with a bias tape maker or you can use stained glass tape. This is black and you iron it. It is thinner and easier to use as a bias binding. Below are links of how to make bias tape and how to use the black tape. There are also bias tape makers that come with a roll of fusible web. That might be even more convenient, but I have to say, 6 mm is very narrow, I didn't find it that easy to make.

- 1. Copy the drawing onto the fabric. I did this with a light box. Indicate the middle. There is a dot on the drawing.
- Cut out the pieces of the flower. There is no seam allowance for this. Place them on the fabric and pin them down. You can thread them on the background, or like I did attach them with a glue pen.
- 3. The strips to make bias tape are cut diagonally, so 45 degrees.
- 4. Now you can finish the pattern. There are numbers on the drawing. You have to follow these numbers to make sure that the ends will fall under the other strips, as much as possible.
- 5. Sew everything on and iron.
