Block of the Month 2024

Blok 9 Like Joseph's Coat

What you'll need:

- Pieces of fabric for the background and pieces for the squares and triangles
- 2. Scissors, rotary cutter, ruler, chalk pencil, frixion pen
- 3. FPP Paper, 3 Sheets, FPP Ruler
- 4. Pins, needles, yarn according to color
- 5. The pattern

FPP

I've used fun-dation paper here. You will need 3 sheets.

Follow the order of sewing per block. Remember that the top of the sheet is where the letters and numbers are legible. So the fabric is sewn at the bottom, the other side. After sewing each part, turn the work over, fold and cut off the excess allowance. Move on to the next block. Iron between essembling.

You have all 9 blocks ready, ironed and cut. Then assemble them in the right order and iron everything in between and at the end.

Traditional

Are you going to make them traditional. Then you need 5 blocks with the square and 4 blocks with flying geese (a total of 8 flying geese). Follow the pattern and assemble the squares. If you have all 9, put them in a row of three in the right order and then connect the rows together. Iron in between and at the end.
