

Block of the Month 2024

Blok 9 Flying geese in a circle

What you'll need:

- Pieces of fabric for the background and pieces for the flying geese.
- Scissors, rotary cutter, ruler.
- FPP paper, 4 sheets, FPP ruler.
- Pins, needles, yarn according to color.
- The pattern.

FPP

I've used fun-dation here. You will need 4 sheets, but of course you can also do it your own way.

Follow the order of sewing per block. Remember that the top of the sheet is where the letters and numbers are legible. So the fabric is sewn on the bottom, the other side.

Turn after each block and cut the excess supplement. Move on to the next block.

You have all four blocks ready, ironed and cut. Then put them together in the right order and iron everything in between and at the end.

Traditional

Are you going to make them traditional. Then you need 4 blocks with the same pattern.

This might help, but perhaps you have other ideas.

I would sew B and F together, then E, then I and C. dat is part 1 (ironing in between)

Then I would sew and iron H and G, that's part 2.

Put parts 1 and 2 together and iron. Then put A on top and end with G.
