

Dutch Postcard

Christmas Table Runner Center Part 4

What you'll need:

- Delft blue fabric 2 different types in total for 6 blocks. Each block is 4.5 x 4.5 with seam allowance.
- Green Fabric for 4 Blocks (5 x 5 inches)
- Red fabric 2 blocks (2 x .75 x 1 1/8 inches, 4 x 2.5 x 1 1/8 inches, 2 x 3 1/8 x 1 1/8 inches)
- Picture for the middle block if you like.
- Strip 2 x Delft Blue Fabric to finish the row, 12.5 x 1.5 inches
- Rulers, rotary cutter, water soluble pen, chalk pen or frixtion pen, pencil, needles, scissors and pins, yarn
- Vliesofix
- Fpp Paper & Ruler
- De templates

Traditional

Here you will need 2 sheets of fun-dation paper or what you normally use. You need 4 green blocks (pdf part 4.0) and 2 blocks of log cabin (pdf part 4.1). Cut out the templates from the green block, draw on the fabric and cut out. Do the same for the Delft blue fabric. Put all the parts together. Iron in between. Then make the 2 red blocks. Cut out the templates, draw on fabrics and cut out. Put all the parts together in order. Put all the blocks together according to the photo. Sew on both sides on the blue strip of the existing quilt and iron. Cut and sew the following blue strips to the other side of the block edge. You're ready for the next round.

FPP Raw edge

Here you will need 2 sheets of fun-dation paper or what you normally use. You need 4 green blocks (pdf part 4.0) and 2 blocks log cabin (pdf part 4.1). Make the blocks according to schedule. Iron in between. Assemble the blocks in the right order and sew together. Secure the blocks to the blue strip of the quilt. On the other side of the block strip, sew the other blue strips. Iron and you're ready for the next round.
